BLOOMINGTON, Ind. – Through a unique and riveting mix of theatre, circus, dance, music, and acrobatics, the stories of the Greatest Generation will be told when *Réversible* takes to the IU Auditorium stage April 2 and 3. This newest production from the Montreal-based circus company 7 Fingers, the same company that brought *Traces* to the Auditorium stage in 2013, will tell the stories of the generation who forged the world we live in today.

Under the direction of Gypsy Snider—who has also choreographed televised feature performances for *America's Got Talent*, *Her Majesty's Royal Variety Performance*, and *The Illusionist: Darcy Oake's Edge of Reality*—the performance of *Réversible*, will tell the stories of the era that inspired poetry, imagination, passion, and staggering virtuosity. With *Réversible*, be prepared for the best contemporary circus as the cast of many talents travel through both time and space.

Snider, originally from San Francisco, is the daughter of the founders of The Pickle Family Circus, earned her degree in Physical Theatre at Scuola Teatro Dimitri in Switzerland, and has performed internationally for over 18 years. She has received a Drama Desk Award and Outer Circus Circle Award for her work with the circus choreography in the 2013 Broadway revival of *Pippin* and the Evolving Circus Award in New York City in 2015.

"Audiences will be delighted and left in awe of this production," said IU Auditorium Executive Director Doug Booher. "With elegant performances from various disciplines in telling the story of the Greatest Generation, it is sure to be a magical live experience for all ages."

Réversible performers will conduct educational outreach events during their stay, including a panel discussion with IU's Project Jumpstart and an on-site workshop with performers at Brown County High School.
